APPLICATION FOR THE EVELYN HAZZARD GRANT**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Evelyn Hazzard Foundation Grant's aim is to support a Deputy Principal in what was previously known as the South West Sydney region- the region that Evelyn served as Deputy Principal throughout her teaching career with a program/initiative they wish to implement that would improve equity in their school.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Schools in the following South Western Sydney Local Areas are eligible:

- Bankstown
- Campbelltown
- East Hills
- Fairfield
- Granville
- Hoxton
- Ingleburn
- Liverpool
- Strathfield
- Macarthur

**APPLICATION :** Applications may be received from any Substantive Deputy Principal from any high school from the previously known South West Sydney Region .Applications must be endorsed by the school Principal.

**CRITERIA:**

- Identify an equity issue effecting student achievement/outcomes in the school community.
- Identify the target group.
- Proposed program or initiative that would address the issue.
- Intended outcomes of the program/initiative.

Examples of programs/initiative may include:

- Inclusivity of a minority
- Improvement in literacy/numeracy skills of targeted group
- Communication skills
- Transitioning

## SELECTION :

Application form must be completed and submitted to the NSW Deputy Principal's Association via email.

- The adjudication committee will consist of members of the Foundation Board and the NSWSDPA.
- The NSW Deputy Principal's Association will notify the recipient of their selection.
- Grant recipient will be listed in the Annual Deputy Principal Conference program.
- The Grant will be presented at the NSW Deputy Principals Conference held in August. The recipient is expected to attend.
- Total Grant Value is \$2000 .

## SUGGESTED INFORMATION

Please provide a detailed outline of:

- The equity issue
- Program/initiative
- How the grant will be used
- Intended outcomes
- How the program/initiative will be evaluated
- Completed document must not exceed TWO A4 pages.

The recipient of the Grant will be required to submit a short report outlining the implementation of the program/initiative and its outcomes .This report will be printed in the Annual Conference Program. It will be due 1st July in the following year of receipt. The following information must be included in the application.
